Word of God: St Luke 10:1-9,17-21 Jesus sends out the 72

10 After this the Lord appointed 72 others. He

sent them out two by two ahead of him. They

went to every town and place where he was about to go. ² He told them, "The harvest is huge, but the workers are few. So ask the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into his harvest field. ³ Go! I am sending you out like lambs among wolves. ⁴ Do not take a purse or bag or sandals. And don't greet anyone on the road.

⁵ "When you enter a house, first say, 'May this house be blessed with peace.' ⁶ If someone there works to bring peace, your blessing of peace will rest on them. If not, it will return to you. ⁷ Stay there, and eat and drink anything they give you. Workers are worthy of their pay. Do not move around from house to house.

⁸ "When you enter a town and are welcomed, eat what is given to you. ⁹ Heal the sick people who are there. Tell them, 'God's kingdom has come near to you.'

¹⁷ The 72 returned with joy. They said, "Lord, even the demons obey us when we speak in your name."

¹⁸ Jesus replied, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. ¹⁹ I have given you authority to walk all over snakes and scorpions. You will be able to destroy all the power of the enemy. Nothing will harm you. ²⁰ But do not be glad when the evil spirits obey you. Instead, be glad that your names are written in heaven."
